He is a founding member of the Clinical Skills Lab which coordinates from 2004 until today. He coordinates also the Primary Health Care courses and he is involved in many courses among which are Social Medicine and Research Methodology. Since 2009 he is a visiting lecturer at King's College London, UK. His research interests include Primary Health Care, General Practice and Medical Education. He has the scientific supervision of the book "Basic Clinical Skills" and the supervision of the translation of "a textbook of General Practice». He published 17 papers in scientific journals and 55 papers in scientific congresses abstracts books. He is the reviewer in 3 scientific journals.
